

Narrominded is proud to present a new work by Coen Oscar Polack. It is also the first ever live registration to be released on Narrominded.

SPECTRAL CHURCHES

The work *Spectral Churches* was commissioned by the StreetCanvas festival and was performed during the first edition of the festival on October 7, 2010, in the middle of the Oude Groenmarkt in Haarlem, The Netherlands. The music on this cd is a multi-tracked live recording of the performance. Only sounds from the bells in the carillon of the Grote of St. Bavokerk in Haarlem are used in this piece. The piece is based on the mechanical bell sequence *De Damiaatjes* that plays every night from 9 p.m. for approximately 26 minutes. *Spectral Churches* is an extrapolation on the sequence and was performed during its course.

The work was presented as a structured improvisation in a six-channel electronic environment alongside live, unamplified playing on the carillon in the belfry of the Grote of St. Bavokerk, and the mechanical bell sequence.

Spectral Churches is available as a limited edition cd and as a digital download.

COEN OSCAR POLACK

Coen Oscar Polack is one of the founders of Narrominded and is a part of Living Ornaments and Psychon. His work under his own name concentrates on installations and performance pieces, based on field recordings, instrumental interventions and found sound. For Narrominded he released three solo cd's and collaborations with Herman Wilken and Puin+Hoop.

ABOUT NARROMINDED

Narrominded is a Dutch record label. Since 2000 we release vinyl, cd's and mp3's by rock bands like Boutros Bubba, Fine China Superbone, Gone Bald and Katadreuffe, and electronic and electroacoustic music by artists like Hunter Complex, Spoelstra, Coen Oscar Polack, Puin + Hoop, Psychon and Living Ornaments. Expected in 2011: new records by Boutros Bubba, Peal, Katadreuffe and Matto Frank. Various releases by Narrominded are available via distributors like Clone, Rush Hour, Decks, Norman Records, Worm and Ear-Rational and online a.o. via iTunes, Bandcamp and Spotify.

Narrominded is run fully independent, both financially and artistically.
